Currie Dinosaur Museum and the Swan City Rotary Club have partnered together to bring disadvantaged groups, or those who otherwise may not be able to attend the museum out for a day trip. Swan City Rotary will cover the cost of transportation, museum admission, guided gallery tour, and a program or National Geographic Film. All eligible organizations are encouraged to fill out the attached application form and return to Jewels Goff, Education/Outreach Programs Coordinator.

## **Details to keep in mind:**

Field Trips are available on select Saturdays as well as during the week. Please note the Museum is only open Mondays from June – August. All dates are on a first come first serve basis and are subject to availability. All field trip programming is planned to be age appropriate and group specific. If you have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to ask.

Groups must have a minimum of 12 participants to run. Transportation will be provided via the Museums 24 passenger Dino Bus. The maximum number of student participants in a group is 18, adult chaperone's/aids are over and above this number. While the Dino Bus is not wheelchair accessible, arrangements can be made to accommodate this. If you have a larger group please contact the museum to discuss possible arrangements.
