

# Summer Camp Counsellor

The Summer Camp Counsellors will be jointly responsible for leading six weeks of summer day camps at the Philip J. Currie Dinosaur Museum. This is an 8-week position running from June 24th-August 30h, 2024 and will consist of leading eight weeks of full-day and half-day summer camps with an age range of 5-13 years old, depending on the camp.

Camps are operated at Pipestone Creek Park and the Philip J. Currie Dinosaur Museum in Wembley, Alberta. This opportunity is ideal for students interested in informal education and the Forest School program.

This is the perfect position for a fun, enthusiastic person who enjoys spending time with children, likes dinosaurs, science and nature.

The ideal candidate will have the following attributes/qualities:

- 1. Comfortable working with children, seniors, and the general public of all ages. Excellent communication skills and feeling comfortable managing children are a must.
