\*Ravens and Grey Jays are most likely to go rafting on Wednesdays, but this is weather dependent. Rafting staff are trained by **Rescue Canada** and waivers for rafting can be signed at the museum when campers are dropped off on Mondays.

## What to bring for Camps:

- Backpack
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Lunch and Snacks
- Spare Clothes (especially socks)
- Sunscreen and Bug Spray
- Hat
- Indoor shoes (Museum Days)
- Outdoor shoes that are OK to be muddy and water shoes for water games and playing in the river.
- Shoes for Rafting (Grey Jays and Ravens)
  - crocs/sandals or water shoes work best, they will get wet and muddy

## Camp Rules:

- Campers (especially chickadees) **must** be able to use the bathrooms independently
- Pack lunches and snacks that are nut-free and do not require heating or hot water as we will not have access to either when out of the museum.
- Drop off is at **9:00am** and pickup is at **4:00pm** at the museum daily and campers will be shuttled to and from the campgrounds with the Museum Dino Bus.
  - Early Drop off (7:00am - 8:30am) and late pick up (4:30pm - 5:00pm) are available with a \$10/day fee in the registration forms so that we may schedule staff accordingly.
- Campers cannot bring personal toys to camp as they may be lost or damaged.
- Campers will make tie-dye shirts on Monday and we ask they wear these shirts to camp on Friday.
- When registering for camp please notify staff of any medical needs or concerns such as inhalers, allergies, or conditions (such as epilepsy or behavioral differences).
