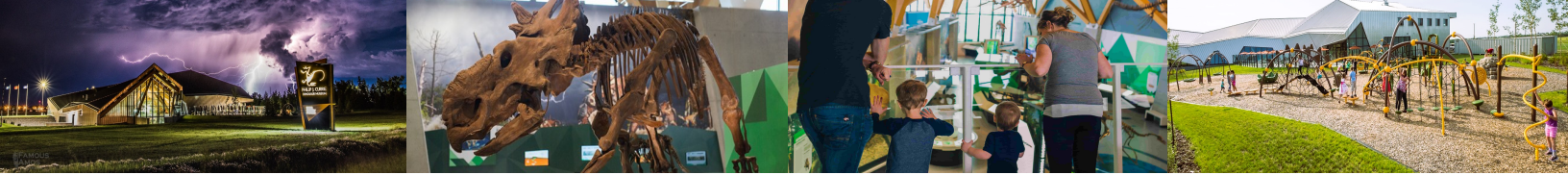


River of DEATH & DISCOVERY DINOSAUR MUSEUM
