SUMMER CAMP PACK LIST

- Refillable water bottle

- Outdoor shoes that are okay to be dirty, muddy, etc.
- Snacks and a lunch (*NUT FREE*, food should not need to be heated or kept in a fridge)
- A backpack
- Towel (optional)
- Water shoes (optional, Jurassic Juniors and Triassic Teens will need shoes for rafting that are okay to be muddy and wet, crocs or water shoes are best, you may want to bring a plastic bag to put them in afterwards)

PLEASE DO NOT PACK

- Personal toys from home
- Food that needs a microwave or to be heated, as well as food that needs to be in a fridge (we will often be away from the museum and have no access to applicances)
- Food containing nuts

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BASIC ITENERARY

- DAY 1: Museum day, entire day will be spent at the museum doing museum based programming.
- DAYS 2-4: Field trips to either Kleskun Hills or Pipestone Creek campground. One of these days is a **potential** rafting day, however it is important to note that this is **weather**, **age**, and **behaviour dependent**. Staff will speak with you prior to the potential rafting day if there is a concern and your child will not be able to raft with the group. If this occurs, alternate programming will be provided for your child.
- DAY 5: Museum day, weather dependent outdoor/water games.

**If you have questions about where specifically the camp will be on a certain day, please ask the summer camp staff. Please note that activities are weather dependent and that the schedule could be changed last minute, you will be informed of this change at drop off. In the event of severe weather (smoke, rain, etc.) we have alternative programming that will be done at the museum.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Rafting is weather, age, and behavior dependent, and therefore not a guarantee. Please ask staff if you have any questions about this. If you have concerns about your child rafting, please contact programming staff at <u>587-771-0662</u>.
- Rafting staff are trained by Rescue Canada and waivers for rafting can be signed at the museum when campers are dropped off.
- Please make sure that your child is aware that sharing food is not allowed due to allergies.
- Please notify staff of any medical needs or concerns such as inhalers, allergies, or behavioural conditions that you feel necessary.
